My personalized Paris Itinerary February Monday 3, 2014

Time Location



9:00 a.m. **Start** at Hotel Le Meurice / 210, rue de Rivoli - 1 Arrondissement

* Walk through Rivoli street against the traffic and find metro line 1(yellow) "Tuleries", take any train direction "La Defense", get off at station "George V". Walk up the hill on the right side of Champs Elysees Avenue. Right before the round about go down the pedestrian tunnel to access the Arc de Triomphe.

9:30 a.m. Arc de Triomphe / Famous Monument commissioned by Napoleon Bonaparte, it commemorate the victories of the French Napoleonic Army

To enter: "Find the entrance to the monument up in the surface again, right underneath the Arc. You will need to walk almost 300 steps up.

° Walk back through the tunnel to the champs Elysees and enter the metro. Find line n° 6 (green), get into any train direction Nation. Get off at station "Trocadero". Follow arrows directing towards the Eiffel Tower.

11:30 a.m. Eiffel Tower / XIX century masterpiece of the engineer Gustave Eiffel

To enter: Approach the North or West Pilar to access through the Priority Line with your ticket.



2:00 p.m. Temporary Animal Exhibit at "Musée de la Quai Branly"

° Walk towards the river Seine and turn right on the Avenue called "Qual Branly", you will see an organic wall, you've arrived to the museum.

° Cross the "Quai Branly" avenue and find a way down to the edge of the **river Seine**, called "Les Berges". Walk in the opposit direction of the Eiffel Tower, you find many activities, kids games and rock climbing wall, cafes, restaurants, music. You wlll walk underneath several bridges all the way to the end where you will find the **Orsay Museum**.



° Go up to the street level and cross the river through the bridge called "Passarelle de Solferino" in front of the Orsay Museum to enter the Tuileries Garden.

4:00 p.m. Tuleries Garden/Former royal garden, find a children playground and comfortable seats perfect to rest. Check the map at the entrance to the garden.

* Walk across the garden to find the street "rue de Rivoli", cross it and walk through "rue de Castiglioni" all the way to "Place Vendôme".

4:30 p.m. Place Vendôme / Find here the finest Parisian Jewelry stores and the famous Ritz hotel. This is a nice spot to take a look the the fancy window displays.

* Keep Walking through "Avenue de la Paix" all the way to the end where you will find the beautiful <u>Opera Garnier</u> on your left side. Cross the Boulevard on your left and you'll find the classical Parisian Café: "Café de la Paix".

5:30 p.m. Dinner reservation: Café de la Paix / This is a typical XIX century parisian café restaurant. Great sea food, excellent service and elegant decoration.

° Walk in the oposit direction of the Opera house through "Blvd des Capucines". At the end you'll find the Madeleine Church (it looks like a Greek temple)

7:00 p.m. Eglise de la Madeleine / Orchestra de Paris - The Fours Seasons

° Walk through the wide street in front of the churches exit: "Rue Royale", on the right side you will be able to the see the famous "Maximes" Restaurant and at the end of the street admire the beautiful Concorde square and the Egyptian Obelisk in the middle. If you pass the zebra lines you can get right by the center of the square and admire the Champs Elysees Avenue and the Arc de Triomphe at night. Next you can walk against the direction of the traffic through Rivoli street and you'll be back at your hotel in 5 min. (0,3 miles away)
